ORDINANCE NO. 652

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, WATER SERVICE, SECTION 6.07, METERS, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE, LEROY, ILLINOIS, 1975 (as amended).

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents that electronic and computer-compatible reading devices, including electronic transponder devices, be obtained and installed on all new meters, when the same are installed, either in new construction or in existing structures,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 6.07 METERS, of Chapter 6, Water Service, of the Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), is hereby amended by adding the following words at the end of the current section:

Whenever the City purchases water meters on or after the effective date of this ordinance, the City shall also purchase devices to be used in connection with said new meters, such devices being generally known as "electronic transponders," which devices shall be used in connection with portable reading devices to "read" the meter usage from time to time without requiring the meter reader to physically view a reading device on the outside of a structure, or to view the meter itself. The City shall also purchase, in connection with such electronic transponders, the necessary computer software, hardware and any other devices or computer software, instruction manuals, and the like, which shall be necessary in order to institute a program whereby the City, through its water department, shall begin to change over all water meters, as the same are replaced in existing structures, and as the same are installed in new construction, in order to facilitate the electronic remote reading of water meters with a view to reducing the expense to the City of reading water meters and billing water meter usage to water meter customers of the City.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law.


