

ORDINANCE NO. 02-12-01-80

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR
THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY OF THE CITY
OF LEROY, MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, the City of Le Roy, being organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, owns the following described real property:

Lot No. 1 of the Stylecraft Subdivision, being part of the Southwest One-Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast One Quarter (NE 1/4) of Section 20, Township 22 North, Range 4 East of the Third Principal Meridian, City of Le Roy, according to the Plat recorded October 22, 2002, as Document No. 2002-37152, in MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS;

Part of Parcel Nos. 15-30-20-251-005, 008, 009;

which property is generally located at 410 N. Hemlock, Le Roy, Illinois and is currently not in use; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Le Roy has determined that it is no longer necessary, appropriate, or in the best interests of said City of Le Roy that it retain title to said real property, and that said real property is not required for the use of, or profitable to, the City of Le Roy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-76-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-2, notice has been given of the proposal to sell such real estate and bids have been invited for the purchase of such real estate, said notice having first been published on May 1, 2002, and having been published for three successive weeks in the Le Roy Journal, a newspaper published in the City of Le Roy; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to said notice bids were opened at the regular meeting of the City Council held on May 20, 2002; and

WHEREAS, the following bids for the purchase of such real estate have been received:

BIDDER: Staley Grain, Inc.

AMOUNT: \$9300.00

and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that the best interest of the City of Le Roy and its residents will be served by the acceptance of the bid submitted by Staley Grain, Inc. and the sale of the aforesaid real estate to such bidder for the amount bid of \$9300.00, which amount represents the high bid;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1: That the City Council find as facts the recitals hereinabove set forth.

Section 2: The bid of Staley Grain, Inc. in the amount of \$9300.00 is hereby accepted by the City Council of the City of Le Roy for the sale of the following described real estate:

Lot No. 1 of the Stylecraft Subdivision, being a part of the Southwest One-Quarter (SW 1/4) of the Northeast One-Quarter of Section 20, Township 22 North, Range 4 East of the Third Principal Meridian, City of Le Roy, according to the Plat recorded October 22, 2002, as Document No. 2002-37152, in MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS;

Part of Parcel No. 15-30-20-251-005, 008, 009;

Section 3: Upon the payment to the City of Le Roy or the securing of the aforesaid bid price, the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to convey and transfer the aforesaid real estate to Staley Grain, Inc., by a proper deed of conveyance, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to acknowledge and attest such deed and to affix thereto the seal of the City of Le Roy.

Section 4: The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed, respectively, to execute and attest such other documents as may be necessary to the conveyance herein authorized.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, by a vote of at least three fourths of the corporate authorities now holding office, and after its approval and publication in pamphlet form, in the manner provided by law.


