**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 8, REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL, MUNICIPAL CODE OF LEROY, ILLINOIS, 1975 (AS AMENDED), BY AMENDMENT OF SECTION 8.06**

**WHEREAS**, the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, has an ordinance providing for refuse collection and disposal and user charges for said collection and disposal; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the City of LeRoy and its residents to amend said ordinance and provide for increases in some of the user fees,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois (hereinafter referred to as "CITY"), in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** Section 8.01 of Chapter 8, refuse collection and disposal, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), is hereby amended by inclusion of an additional definition as new sub-section (t-A), as follows:

(t-A). **Residential Unit.** Any apartment, separate single-family dwelling or single-person dwelling in an apartment building, or a duplex apartment building, or any other similar residential space set aside for the separate and complete use of a single-person, single-family, or the like. Such unit may also be referred to as a "dwelling unit," or "residential unit." Mobile homes, single-family dwellings and house trailers will also be considered as "residential units," or "dwelling units."

**SECTION 2. REFUSE FEES FOR A CALENDAR MONTH FOR EACH CLASSIFICATION OF REFUSE COLLECTION CUSTOMERS SHALL BE AS FOLLOWS:**

- (i) Sub-sections b. and c. are hereby repealed.
- (ii) New sub-sections b. and c. of the aforesaid Section 8.06 are hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

**b. Monthly Fees for Commercial and Business Establishments, and Other Institutions and Non-residential Refuse Collection Customers.**

**NOTE:** A commercial or business establishment qualifying for treatment as a residential unit may enter into an agreement with the landlord of the premises or an adjacent business, or the landlord of an adjacent premises, to place the trash and refuse from the first commercial or business establishment in a dumpster maintained by the landlord of the premises in which the commercial establishment or business is located, or maintained by an adjacent business or the landlord of an adjacent property, but in all other respects the commercial or business establishment will still be billed as a separate unit and may not exceed the limit of trash or refuse of five trash cans to be picked up once per week.

**c. Multi-Family Dwellings, being a residential building, complex of residential building, or a mobile home park, containing 2 or more separate dwellings units, shall be billed per unit even if one or more dumpsters are used for the convenience of the landlord, tenants, or both.**

**SECTION 3.** The aforesaid amendments and rate changes are deemed effective November 1, 1991.

**SECTION 4.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.


