

ORDINANCE NO. 120

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE, LE ROY, ILLINOIS, CHAPTER 34, Section 34.18 "Liquor".

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois that Section 34.18 be amended by deleting "It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the city between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 7 A.M. on any day or between the hours of 12 mid-night on Saturday and 7:00 A.M. on Monday following" and adding "It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the city between the hours of 1:00 A.M. and 7 A.M. on any day or between the hours of 1:00 A.M. on Sunday and 7:00 A.M. on Monday following."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval, as required by law.


