ORDINANCE NO. 741

AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT HIRING STANDARDS FOR PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF LEROY, MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, is subject to the requirements of Section 5/3.1-30-21 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/3.1-30-21, 1996 State Bar Edition);

WHEREAS, by statute of the State of Illinois, municipalities employing part-time police officers shall, by ordinance, establish hiring standards for part-time police officers and shall submit those standards to the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy wish to remain in compliance with the laws of the State of Illinois regarding hiring and supervising of part-time policy officers,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled as follows:

Section 1: All part-time police officers of the City of LeRoy shall meet or exceed classifications and requirements to permit such officer entering and successfully completing training under the Inter-Governmental Law Enforcement Officer's In-Service Training Act requirements (as established by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board). Further, all part-time police officers shall be appointed based on meeting the standards and requirements as set forth in the City of LeRoy Police Department Personnel Policy Manual, and such part-time police officers of the City of LeRoy shall be subject to voluntary or non-voluntary termination of their appointment in accordance with the regulations and standards set forth in the City of LeRoy Police Department Personnel Policy Manual.

<u>Section 2</u>: Passing of the mandated training requirements set forth by the State of Illinois in the Ilinois Inter-Governmental Law Enforcement Officers In-Service Training Act is required.

Section 3: Any part-time police officer employed by the City of LeRoy after January 1, 1996, who has not yet received certification under Section 8.2 of the Illinois Police Training Act (50 ILCS 705/8.2) shall be directly supervised.

Section 4: The City Clerk of the City of LeRoy is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board, as required by statute.

<u>Section 5</u>: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval, passage and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law.

Section 6: Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or any liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 2 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

<u>Section 7</u>: All ordinances, or parts thereof, and all resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect as set forth hereafter.
