

AN ORDINANCE FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois:

That there shall be a general election in the City of LeRoy on the 17th day of April, 1979.

That at such election there shall be elected for the city, for a full term as provided by law, the following officers:

One alderman in each of the wards of the city, namely Wards Number One to Three inclusive.

That at such election there also shall be elected to fill vacancy, one alderman in Ward Two.

That the ballot for such election shall be in the form prescribed by statute and the said election shall be conducted in compliance with the general election laws.

That polling places shall be open from 6 a.m. until 6 p.m. The precincts or voting districts, and the polling places, for such election shall be those prescribed by the Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975, as amended, establishing wards and polling places for all general elections in the city.

That the judges of election for each voting district shall be:

Ward 1: Betty Lowe, Lucille Norfleet, Lucille Gross
Margaret Mears, Alternate

Ward 2: Eleanor Yount, Fawn Oneal, Faye Hart

Ward 3: Della Dee Johnston, Ellen Umstattd, Marjorie Badger
Mildred Wilson, Alternate

That the city clerk shall prepare the necessary ballots, tally sheets, poll books and all necessary supplies for the conduct of such election, and all supplies and materials necessary for the counting of the ballots, making of returns and preservation of the ballots as required by the general election law.

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and approval as required by law.
