

ORDINANCE NO. 686

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 34, LIQUOR, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF LEROY, ILLINOIS 1975 (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents that the closing hours for certain types of holders of certain liquor licenses issued by the City of LeRoy be changed from the current restrictions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents to raise the fees charged for obtaining certain types of liquor licenses;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. Section 34.09 CLASSIFICATION AND FEES. B. (3)., of the Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), and Section 3 of Ordinance No. 222, are hereby repealed.

Section 2. New section 34.09 CLASSIFICATION AND FEES B. (3)., of the Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), is hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

"(3). Class "C" licenses - shall authorize the retail sale on the premises specified for consumption off the premises of alcoholic liquors as follow:

- a. Retail sale of alcoholic liquor on premises specified for consumption off the premises, not including the right to have Sunday sales - Class "C/I" license. The annual fee for such license shall be \$500.00.
- b. Retail sale of alcoholic liquor on premises specified for consumption off the premises - including the right to have Sunday sales - Class "C/I - S" license. The annual fee for such license shall be \$750.00.
- c. Retail sale of beer and fortified wine on the premises specified for consumption off the premises - not including the right to have Sunday sales - Class "C/II" license. The annual fee for such license shall be \$255.00.
- d. Retail sale of beer and fortified wine on the premises specified for consumption off the premises - including the right to have Sunday sales - Class "C/II-S" license. The annual fee for such license shall be \$505.00.

Section 3. Section 34.30 CLOSING HOURS., Chapter 34 of the Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, 1975 (as amended), is hereby repealed.

Section 4. New Section 34.30 CLOSING HOURS., of Chapter 34, LIQUOR, of the Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, 1975 (as amended), is hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

It shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the City between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any day. Further, for all holders of liquor licenses except Class "C/I-S and C/II-S" licenses, it shall be unlawful to offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the City between the hours of 1:00 a.m. Sunday and 7:00 a.m. on Monday following. As to Class "C/I-S and C/II-S" license holders, it shall be unlawful to sell or offer for sale at retail any alcoholic liquor in the City not only between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 7:00 a.m. on any day, but also between the hours of 1:00 a.m. Sunday and 9:00 a.m. on the same Sunday, and 6:00 p.m. Sunday and 7:00 a.m. on Monday following. It shall be unlawful to keep open for business or to admit the public to any premises in or on which alcoholic liquor is sold at retail during the hours in which the sale of liquor is prohibited. In the case of restaurants, such establishments may be kept open during such hours, but no alcoholic liquor may be sold to or consumed by the public during such hours unless such restaurant is the holder of a Class "D" license, in which case the hours for sales of liquor on Sunday shall be as set forth in connection with the designation for Class "D" license privileges as set forth under Section 34.09 B.

Section 5. All ordinances, or parts thereof, and all resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with this ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect as set forth hereafter.

Section 6. Nothing in this ordinance hereby adopted shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any act or ordinance hereby repealed as cited in Section 5 of this ordinance; nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this ordinance.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form, as required by law.

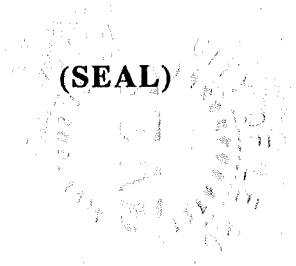
