ORDINANCE NO. 784

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy, being organized under the laws of the State of Illinois and having less than 500,000 population, owns personal property which in the opinion of a simple majority of the corporate authorities now holding office is no longer necessary or useful to, or for, the best interests of said City; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the corporate authorities now holding office at a regular meeting held at 7:00 p.m. on January 19, 1998, did make the aforesaid determination,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled:

Section 1: The 1978 Ford two-ton flatbed truck (VIN: F70EVBA 6150) shall be converted by the Superintendent of Streets/Street Department Head in to some other form that is useful to the City by using the material in the personal property for parts for other vehicles maintained by the City.

Section 2: The 1983 S-10 pickup truck with longbed and topper (VIN: IGCBS14A7D2160611) shall be sold by the City Clerk of the City of LeRoy by advertising as that official deems appropriate, whether by newspaper, posting notices on local bulletin boards, or otherwise. The City Clerk is hereby authorized to accept any offer of cash of not less than \$100.00 to purchase the vehicle, "as is."

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
