ORDINANCE NO. 13-03-02-80

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF
SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY
OWNED BY THE CITY OF LEROY**

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the City of LeRoy, it is no longer necessary or useful to or for the best interest of the City of LeRoy to retain ownership of the personal property hereinafter described in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy to dispose of the property listed on Exhibit A in the manner determined by the City Administrator to be in the best interests of the City with the exception of the four listed firearms, which shall be sold to a licensed firearms dealer or otherwise destroyed; and

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy is authorized by Section 11-76-4 of the Municipal Code to dispose of surplus personal property in any manner approved by ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois.

SECTION TWO: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-76-4), the Mayor and the City Council of the City of LeRoy find that the following described personal property in the attached Exhibit A, now owned by the City of LeRoy, is no longer necessary or useful to the City of LeRoy and the best interests of the City of LeRoy will be served by sale as instructed above.

SECTION THREE: Pursuant to Section 11-76-4, the City Administrator and/or his designees are hereby authorized and directed to sell the aforementioned personal property now owned by the City of LeRoy in accordance with the instructions set forth in this Ordinance.

SECTION FOUR: The various provisions of this Ordinance are to be considered as severable, and if any part or portion of this Ordinance shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION FIVE: All prior Ordinances and Resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION SIX: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


