

SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE NO. 84
CITY OF LEROY 1978-1979

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEROY, MC LEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section I. That for the purposes of deferring the necessary expenses of the City of LeRoy for the salary of police for the remainder of the fiscal year commencing May 1, 1978 and ending April 30, 1979, said remainder of the year being the period December 1, 1978 through April 30, 1979, in addition to the sums already appropriated for said purpose for said fiscal year, the following sum or so much thereof as by law may be authorized, be and the same is hereby set aside and appropriated for the following purpose:

Administration

For the salary of police..... \$4,306.80

Section II. That said sum is appropriated as being an amount not in excess of the aggregate of additional revenue available to the municipality and estimated to be received by the municipality subsequent to the adoption of the annual appropriation ordinance for fiscal year 1978-1979.

Section III. That if any section, subdivision, sentence or clause of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or to be unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this Ordinance.

Section IV. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval. Publication, notice and public hearing in regard to this Ordinance is not applicable as provided by Chapter 24, Section 8-2-7, Illinois Revised Statutes.


