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

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE NO 02-11-01-10

TAX LEVY ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY FOR THE YEAR
ENDING DECEMBER 31, 2003

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, has heretofore regularly and legally passed the ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE for said City for the fiscal year ending April 30, 2003, and which ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE was legally and duly published in pamphlet form as provided by law, and more than ten (10) days prior hereto, and which APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE is by reference made a part hereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, in regular session on this 4th day of November, 2002, as follows;




