## ORDINANCE # 04-12-01-10

### AN ORDINANCE LEVYING TAXES FOR CORPORATE PURPOSES FOR THE CURRENT YEAR COMMENCING ON THE FIRST DAY OF MAY, 2005 AND ENDING ON THE THIRTIETH DAY OF APRIL, 2006 FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY, McLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois as follows:

SECTION ONE: A property tax for the following sums of money, or as much thereof as may be authorized by law shall be levied to defray all expenses and liabilities of the City of Le Roy for the purposes specified against all taxable property in the City of Le Roy, Illinois, for the fiscal year commencing on the first day of May, 2005 and ending on the thirtieth day of April, 2006.



TRUTH IN TAXATION CERTIFICATE OF COMPLIANCE  
ALL COUNTIES EXCEPT COOK

**Note:** The following certificate is only a suggested format. The county clerk may require a different certificate to be signed by the presiding officer of the taxing district certifying compliance with the Truth in Taxation law or that the law is inapplicable.

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the presiding officer of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, (Legal Name of Taxing District), and as such presiding officer I certify that the levy ordinance, a copy of which is attached, was adopted pursuant to, and in all respects in compliance with the provisions of Section 18-60 through 18-85 of the "Truth in Taxation" law.

Check one of the choices below:

- 1) The taxing district published a notice in the newspaper and conducted a hearing meeting the requirements of the Truth in Taxation Law.
- 2) The taxing district's aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a notice and a hearing were not necessary.
- 3) The proposed aggregate levy did not exceed a 5% increase over the prior year's extension. Therefore, a hearing was not held. The adopted aggregate tax levy exceeded 5% of the prior year's extension and a notice was published within 15 days of its adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Law.
- 4) The adopted levy exceeded the amount stated in the published notice. A second notice was published within 15 days of the adoption in accordance with the Truth in Taxation Law.
