TAX LEVY ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF LE ROY, FOR  
THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING APRIL 30, 1982.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, has heretofore regularly and legally passed the ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE for said City for the fiscal year ending April 30, 1982, and which ANNUAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE was legally and duly published in pamphlet form as provided by law, and more than ten (10) days prior hereto, and which APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE is by reference made a part hereof,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, in regular session this 3rd day of August, 1981:

Section 2. The total amount of Three Hundred Thirty-three Thousand one Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars (\$333,128.00) ascertained as aforesaid, be, and the same is hereby levied and assessed on all property subject to taxation within the City of LeRoy according to the value of said property as the same is assessed and equalized for state and county purposes for the current year.

Section 3. That there is hereby certified to the County Clerk of McLean County, Illinois, the several sums aforesaid, constituting said total amount of Three Hundred Thirty-three Thousand One Hundred Twenty-eight Dollars (\$333,128.00), which said total amount the City of LeRoy requires to be raised by taxation for the current fiscal year of said City, and the City Clerk of said city is hereby ordered and directed to file with the County Clerk of said county on or before the time required by law, a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect immediately on and after its passage and approval.




