

USE OF PARK SPACE AND FACILITIES FOR ALL LEROY CITY PARKS

All parks and playgrounds maintained by the City of LeRoy are considered public spaces, and, as such, are available for use by any and all residents. To facilitate use of space, facilities must be reserved, on a first come basis, through LeRoy City Hall.

This includes use of the pavilions at Falcon Ridge, Wilson, Bowman, and Howard Virgin parks, as well as the bandstand in Kiwanis Park. It also includes the ball field at Brickyard Fields, and the entirety of any park used for a community or organizational event.

There is no charge to reserve any of these spaces, but all do require advance bookings through city hall. Facilities may be reserved by calling .309-962-3031, ext. 2.

Note: The Brickyards ball fields are in high demand during youth baseball, softball, soccer and various recreation programs. After game and practice schedules have been made for local leagues and organizations, the available field time will be opened to others for practice.

Currently, we only know of two organizations, (Le Roy Summer League and Stars) who are planning to use the ball field. We strongly suggest that both organizations confer on scheduling before reporting dates to City Hall, in an effort to eliminate potential double-booking of the ball field.

All ordinances adopted by the city are in force when events are held. Alcohol is not permitted in any city park or playgrounds, and open fires (within a fire ring) are allowed only at Howard Virgin Park. Further, it is the responsibility of any group or individual reserving space to assure that the grounds and facilities are cleaned and free of trash or debris at the conclusion of the event.

When space is reserved for a public event, the City requires that the person/organization reserving the space provide insurance, naming the City as co-insured. The required amount is one million dollars coverage each for the city and the host individual or group/organization.
