**ORDINANCE NO. 25-11-02-70**

**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING ENFORCEMENT CONCERNING  
INOPERABLE AND ABANDONED VEHICLES IN THE CITY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of LeRoy has authority, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code, to define and abate nuisances; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of LeRoy has authority, pursuant to the Illinois Motor Vehicle Code to remove abandoned and junk vehicles from public and private property. and

**WHEREAS**, question has arisen regarding the authority of staff to enforce state statutes and city ordinances in connection with inoperable, abandoned and junk vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of LeRoy to provide guidance to city staff regarding enforcement authority concerning these subjects.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF LE ROY  
MCLEAN COUNTY ILLINOIS as follows:**

**Section 1.** That the City Code and Code Compliance Officer is hereby authorized and directed to enforce all city ordinances and state statutes dealing with junk, abandoned, wrecked and inoperable vehicles located on private property within the city limits of the City of LeRoy.

**Section 2.** At the Police Department at the city, the LeRoy Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to enforce all state statutes and city ordinances dealing with junk, wrecked, abandoned and inoperable vehicles located on public property including, but not limited to, streets, alleys and public parking lots within the City of LeRoy.

**Section 3.** That the City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to provide additional guidance to the city Code Compliance Officer and the City Police Chief with regard to

enforcement of the aforementioned ordinances and statutes and all parties are encouraged to cooperate with one another in the enforcement of these ordinances and statutes.

**Section 5.** To the extent that the general direction provided herein conflicts with any specific city code provision, said code provision shall be brought to the attention of the city Administrator for future review and amendment by the City Council.

**Section 6. Severability.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance is held invalid, the invalidity of such section, paragraph, clause or provision shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

**Section 7. Repealer.** All ordinances, resolutions or orders, or parts thereof, which conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**Section 8. Publication.** The City Clerk, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to publish this ordinance in pamphlet form as provided by law.

**Section 9. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage, approval and publication.


