ORDINANCE NO. 26-05-02-80

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRADE-IN AND PURCHASE OF POLICE SQUAD CARS

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy has authority pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code to dispose of personal property by the trade of said property for other personal property; and

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy desires to purchase a new 2026 police squad car and trade in an old squad car therefor; and

WHEREAS, the City Code provides that the City Administrator may dispose of and trade personal property as authorized by ordinance approved by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of LeRoy to authorize the City Administrator to trade in the old police squad car identified in Exhibit A and purchase the new 2026 police squad car identified in Exhibit A from the local dealer identified in Exhibit A, who has agreed to honor the state of Illinois purchasing price.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council for the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. That the City Administrator is authorized to trade in the vehicle described in Exhibit A attached hereto towards the purchase of a new 2026 police squad car identified in Exhibit A.

Section 2. **Recitals.** The foregoing Recitals are incorporated herein and form a part of this Ordinance.

Section 3. **Publication.** The City Clerk be and is hereby authorized and directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form as provided by law.

Section 4. **Severability.** In the event any part of this Ordinance shall be found and

determined to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, all valid parts that are severable from this invalid part shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herein, are hereby repealed, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall affect any rights, action, or causes of action, which have accrued to the City of LeRoy, prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten (10) days following its publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
