

ORDINANCE NO. 01-02-03-50

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING A DEDICATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY TO THE CITY OF LEROY, MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

(real estate to be dedicated: A part of the Illinois Central Gulf Railroad right of way lying in the W1/2 of the NE1/4 of Section 21, T22N, R4E of the 3rd P.M., City of LeRoy, Illinois, more particularly described. . .)

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have received an offer to dedicate a portion of real estate to be used for public street purposes, as a dedication of right-of-way, and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy have determined that said dedication of right-of-way is in the best interests of the City and its residents and that acceptance of the same is appropriate,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. The dedication of right-of-way as shown on the right-of-way dedication plat (having a parcel identification number as follows: underlying lands -PIN: (Bk. 15) 30-21-256-008), a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby approved and accepted.

Section 2. The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby directed to cause a copy of this ordinance and of the attached plat to be recorded promptly in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds in McLean County, Illinois. Upon recording the same, the City Clerk shall provide a copy of the recorded ordinance to the individual having made the dedication, Dorothy Golden, for her records.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication, as required by law.


