

Ordinance No. 10

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois in regular session this 17th day of November, 1975 that Ordinance 42.13 of the Municipal Code, of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois be amended to conform with Public Act 79-159 House Bill 0381, Chapter 23, Section 2371 of the Illinois Statutes to decrease the age of minors as follows:

(a) It is unlawful for a person less than 17 years of age to be present at or upon any public assembly, building, place, street or highway at the following times unless accompanied and supervised by a parent, legal guardian or other responsible companion at least 18 years of age approved by a parent or legal guardian or unless engaged in a business or occupation which the laws of this State authorize a person less than 17 years of age to perform:

1. Between 12:01 A. M. and 6:00 A. M. Saturdays;
2. Between 12:01 A. M. and 6:00 A. M. Sunday; and
3. Between 11:00 P. M. on Sunday to Thursday, inclusive, and 6:00 A. M. on the following day.

(b) It is unlawful for a parent, legal guardian or other person to knowingly permit a person in his custody or control to violate sub-paragraph (a) of this Section.

(c) A person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Section shall be guilty of a petty offense, and shall be fined not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00.

All prior ordinances and legislative codes of this City in conflict are hereby repealed.
