AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MUNICIPAL CODE, LeROY, ILLINOIS, 1975, CHAPTER 34, LIQUOR, SECTIONS 34.31 C AND 34.34.

WHEREAS, the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, has, previous to the date of this ordinance, enacted a comprehensive liquor control ordinance (Ordinance No. 156, adopted December 7, 1981), and

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Illinois, under Public Act 84-767, effective September 21, 1985, has amended Chapter 43, paragraph 149, Illinois Revised Statutes 1983 (as amended), providing that local liquor control commissioners may not only revoke or suspend liquor licenses as issued by the commissioner if the commissioner determines that the licensee is violating any of the provisions of the Illinois Liquor Control Act of 1934, or of any valid local ordinance or resolution, but also may levy fines in lieu of suspension or revocation of the liquor license,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled:

Section 1. That Section 34.31 C Suspension and Revocation of License is hereby amended as follows:

The heading of said subsection "Suspension and Revocation of License." is hereby amended by deleting the period at the end thereof and adding the words "and Levying of Fines."; further, the first two lines of said subsection are further amended by deleting the words "To suspend and to revoke any license" and substituting therefor the following words: "To levy a fine in lieu of suspension or revocation of any license issued, or to suspend, or to revoke any license issued."

Section 2. That Section 34.34 is hereby amended by deleting the period in the seventh line of said section and substituting therefor a comma and adding words prior to the word "In" as follows: "or the local Liquor Control Commissioner may, in lieu of suspension or revocation of the liquor license of such licensee, levy a fine not in excess of \$1,000.00 for each violation on said license holder, with each day on which a violation continues constituting a separate violation; however, not more than \$10,000.00 in total fines may be imposed against any licensee during the period of his license."

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.




