

ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PREVAILING WAGE RATE FOR PUBLIC WORKS OF THE CITY OF LEROY, ILLINOIS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois:

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois has enacted "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, being Section 39s-1 through 39s-12, Chapter 48, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1973, and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid Act requires that the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workmen in the locality of said City of LeRoy employed in performing construction of public works, for said City of LeRoy.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEROY, ILLINOIS:

SECTION 1: To the extent and as required by "An Act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workmen employed in any public works by the State, County, City or any public body or any political subdivision or by any one under contract for public works", approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workmen engaged in the construction\*of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the McLean County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of June of 1987, a copy of that determination being attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

SECTION 2. Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction\*of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

SECTION 3. The City Clerk for the City of LeRoy shall publicly post or keep available for inspection, by any interested party in the main office of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

SECTION 4. The City Clerk of the City of LeRoy shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their names and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workmen whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 5. The City Clerk of the City of LeRoy shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

SECTION 6. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.




