AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12 NUISANCES, SECTION 12.06, MUNICIPAL CODE OF LeROY, ILLINOIS 1975 (AS AMENDED).

Whereas the legislature of the State of Illinois has amended paragraph 11-40-3 of the Municipal Code of 1961 (Chapter 24, §11-40-3, Illinois Revised Statutes 1981 (as amended)), to provide that an "inoperable motor vehicle" means any motor vehicle from which, for a period of at least 60 days, the engine, wheels or other parts have been removed, or on which the engine, the wheels or other parts have been altered, damaged or otherwise so treated that the vehicle is incapable of being driven under its own motor power, and

Whereas, Section 12.06 ABANDONED VEHICLES (d) Disposition of Wrecked or Discarded Vehicles, provides that "no person in charge or control of any property within the city, whether as owner, tenant, occupant, lessee, or otherwise, shall allow any partially dismantled, nonoperating, wrecked, junked, or discarded vehicle to remain on such property longer than 7 days", and

Whereas the City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, finds that it is in the best interests of the city and its citizens that the aforesaid section of the city nuisance ordinances be amended in order that it not in any manner be in violation of the state statutes regarding the same,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled:

Section 1. That Section 12.06 ABANDONED VEHICLES (d) Disposition of Wrecked or Discarded Vehicles of Chapter 12 Nuisances, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), be further amended by substitution of the number "60" in place of the number "7" in each place in said subsection (d) where the number "7" now appears.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
