AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 3, CITY ADMINISTRATION,  
MUNICIPAL CODE OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS 1975 (AS AMENDED)

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, have determined that it is in the best interests of the City and its residents, in administering and enforcing the ordinances of the City, that an informal procedure be provided whereby persons charged with violation of certain municipal ordinances of the City may make a payment to the City and dispose of said charge in an informal, non-criminal-type proceeding,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 3, City Administration, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), Section 3.11, is hereby adopted in words and figures as follows:

3.11. Settlement of Certain Ordinance Violation Charges. The City Marshal and all special policemen under the direction of the City Marshal (the City Marshal and such special policemen being referred to from time to time as the City of LeRoy Police Department) may issue citations for violations of Sections of the Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois, hereinafter specified. The citation form will inform the alleged violator(s) of the opportunity to settle the violation(s) by paying the amount(s) specified herein. This type of payment may be made at the LeRoy City Hall from the third regular weekday (Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.) through the tenth regular weekday (Monday-Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.) after the issuance of each such citation. Each alleged violator must appear in person at the LeRoy City Hall to resolve charges in this manner. The failure to resolve such charges as specified herein will subject the alleged violator to possible ordinance prosecution in the Circuit Court of McLean County by one or more legal representatives of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, in accordance with this Municipal Code and the policies of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, concerning prosecution of ordinance violations.

To resolve charges in this manner each alleged violator must sign a statement that he or she committed or is otherwise responsible for the alleged violation and releasing the City of LeRoy, its employees and agents, from any further litigation associated with the violation or the events surrounding the issuance of the charge(s) against the person. The information associated with the case and the signed statement may be used in administrative or judicial litigation against other parties. Any violations which may be charged and the penalties for the same, all of which may be resolved in the manner previously set forth herein, are as follows:

Section 2. That Chapter 5 of the Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), is hereby amended by changing the title of said chapter from "PARKS" to "PARKS AND RECREATION AREAS."

Section 3. That Chapter 5, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), is hereby amended by addition of subsection H. under Section 2 of said chapter, which new subsection H. shall be as follows:

H. It is unlawful for any person who uses a park or recreation area of the City of LeRoy as an exercise area for domesticated animals to leave unremoved animal feces in said park or recreation area.

Section 4. Section 13.01, Dogs at Large, of Chapter 13, Dogs and Other Animals, Municipal Code of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), is hereby repealed, and new Section 13.01 is hereby adopted as follows:

13.01. Domesticated Animals at Large. It shall be unlawful for any person to permit any domesticated animal to run at large in the City at any time. Any domesticated animal which is on any street, alley, sidewalk or public place; or not on a leash, or not under the direct control of its owner, or not on the owner's property or place of residence shall be deemed to be running at large.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.






