**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 41 TRAFFIC,  
MUNICIPAL CODE OF LE ROY, ILLINOIS, 1975 (as amended),  
BY ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW SECTION 41.02.5 SOUND AMPLIFICATION SYSTEMS**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, hereinafter referred to as "CITY," have determined that motor vehicles within the City frequently are operated in such a way that amplified sound can be heard at an extremely high volume for great distances from the moving vehicle, and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and City Council of the City of LeRoy, Illinois, wish to provide for the regulation of such sound amplification systems,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of LeRoy, McLean County, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

**SECTION 1.** No driver of any motor vehicle within the City of LeRoy shall operate or permit operation of any sound amplification system which can be heard outside the vehicle from 75 or more feet when the vehicle is being operated upon any highway, unless such system is being operated to request assistance or to warn of a hazardous situation. "Highway" is defined for the purposes of this section as being the entire width between the boundary lines of every way, publicly maintained, when any part thereof is opened to the use of the public for purposes of vehicular travel. The distance of measurement shall be deemed to be from the point of the vehicle nearest the point to which the measurement is made. This section does not apply to authorized emergency vehicles or vehicles lawfully engaged in advertising.

**SECTION 2.** Chapter 3, City Administration, of the Municipal Code of the City of LeRoy, Illinois 1975 (as amended), section 3.11 is hereby amended by the addition of the following words and figures at the end of Subdivision 4. - TRAFFIC, of said section and previous to the subdivision numbered 5. - OFFENSES REGARDING AND IN REGARD TO MINORS:
