ORDINANCE NUMBER 06-09-03-90

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF A PUBLIC STREET

WHEREAS, the City of Le Roy, McLean County, Illinois, an Illinois municipal corporation, has as public roadway that is presently referred to as Dixie Court.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Le Roy deem it appropriate to rename the public street, said street being presently referred to as Dixie Court,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Le Roy, Illinois, in lawful meeting assembled, as follows:

Section 1. That the name of Dixie Court is hereby changed from Dixie Court to Persimmon Drive.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as required by law.
